Director of Extraction and Product Development

JOB OVERVEW

The Director of Extraction oversees the preparation and the extraction process of medical marijuana plants in accordance with the state and company standards. This position is responsible for developing and documenting the standard operating procedures for extraction and proprietary processing techniques. The Director will provide oversight of weighing, packaging, labeling and documentation of all products, as well as the tracking of batch numbers, lot numbers and expiration dates. The director will also be responsible for providing the executive team reports associated with process efficiency, efficiency, and quality.

ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Provide expert recommendations on specific medical marijuana product formulations to meet the needs of patients and strategic approaches set forth by the executive team.
- Oversee daily laboratory activities for extraction and processing of medical cannabis products.
- Assess the product inventory requirements and coordinate with grow team to ensure an adequate supply of medical cannabis is available to meet all facets of the company's strategic approach.
- Provide weekly, monthly, annual reporting on production of medical cannabis products, sales projections, and compliance.
- Manage vendor relationships for extraction and processing equipment to ensure equipment quality is optimal.
- Work with local, state-approved laboratories to provide samples for regular testing of plant material and extracted product and ensure all results are documented in compliance with state regulations.
- Ensure that sanitation, safety and security protocols are strictly enforced throughout the facility in accordance with the company's standard operating procedures and state regulations.
- Works in conjunction with the fulfillment department to ensure that products are produced in accordance with demand.

- Manage extraction and processing facility personnel, ensuring all standard operating procedures are strictly adhered.
- Ensure all extraction and processing personnel are fully trained on the company's procedures and policies, and reinforced or updated as needed.
- Design statistically grounded studies to optimize each individual piece of equipment and process to meet efficiency, efficacy, and quality targets set forth by the executive team.

EDUCATION/ EXPERIENCE:

Experience in product development is preferred.

Experience in cGMP manufacturing processes is preferred.
